sonal development and service to the community. Each honoree is awarded a certificate of commendation from the Van Nuys Rotary Club and a \$50 US Savings Bond.

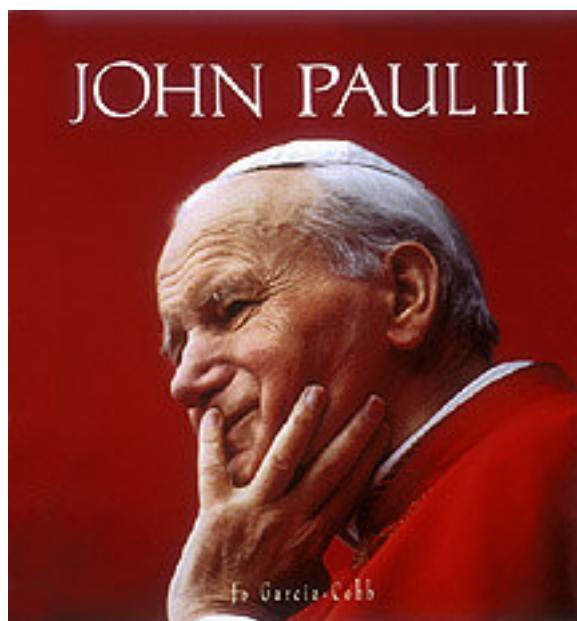

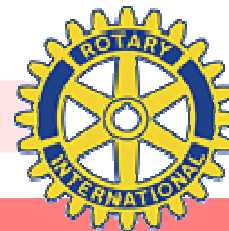
