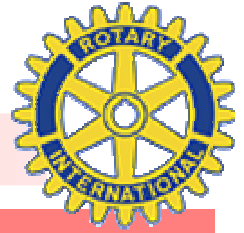
Thank you to everyone and for your participation and prayers that we "DO" remember at each of our Club meetings.
